港大同學會小學擴建新教學樓

擴建校舍，延續夢想

2000年，一群敢於造夢，樂於承擔的香港大學校友，為了向年輕一代提供優質教育，成立了「香港大學畢業同學會教育基金」(教育基金)，並在2002年創辦全日制直資男女小學 -- 「港大同學會小學」(本校)，其後與在2006年開辦的「港大同學會書院」連成「一條龍」的十二年一貫優質教育。

本校創辦15年來實踐辦學理念，提供全人和優質教育，讓學校成為一個愉快學習的社群，每位同學都成為愉快的、能飛躍的星星，深受家長歡迎及業界肯定。學校教師在2014-16年連續兩年獲得行政長官卓越教學獎的獎項。而學生積極參與各類學術、演藝、運動等活動和校外比賽，屢獲佳績。2015年，在香港中學文憑考試中取得5星級狀元成績的兩名「港大同學會書院」同學，均來自本校。2017年，本校小一學額為120，申請入學人數為5,773。

建設新翼教學大樓：拓展新的教學設施、創建新的教學模式

本校設施現時已不能滿足新的教學需要及創建的新教學模式，因此預備擴建一間樓高四層的新翼大樓，總面積約10,000平方呎，提供更多元化及體驗學習的空間，包括：

- 一個面積更大的圖書館 -- 約1,800平方呎，較現時增大50%，以推廣閱讀，培養學生自學；
- 一個多功能的禮堂 -- 設有130個座位及小舞台，作為全級性體驗活動及綜合藝術學習，以及為學生、老師、家長和教育界同行提供分享和展示潛能的場地；
- STEM 夢工場 -- 推行科學、科技、數學和工程教育，以便學生動手創造、設計和實踐；
- 天台花園及農圃 -- 讓學生親手栽培瓜果水果，培育永續生活及熱愛環保的意識。

「愉快星星」捐款計劃

本着一貫以四大基石 -- 「愛心與專業的結合，東西方文化的結合，學校與家庭的結合，學校與社會的結合」的辦學宗旨，教育基金提出「愉快星星」的籌款計劃，邀請更多港大校友，家長及各持份者積極參與，支持本校建設新翼大樓。「愉快星星」的捐款計劃的詳情如下：

- 捐款者可贊助一顆星星，最低捐款額為港幣15,000元或以上；
- 星星捐款類別包括：鑽石星榮譽(HK\$1,000,000或以上)、白金星榮譽(HK\$500,000)、金星榮譽(HK\$200,000)、至尊星榮譽(HK\$100,000)、銀星榮譽(HK\$45,000)及銅星榮譽(HK\$15,000)；
- 按照贊助星星的總數，建構一幅美麗的星星圖畫，為愉快學習的校園添加活力。
- 星星的具體尺寸，畫面分佈及牆壁位置均以建築師最後設計為準，並須獲本校校董會核准。具體資料將會適時公布；
- 為鳴謝熱心捐款人士，在新翼大樓設置的牆壁上表列捐款人選用名稱。
- 此捐款計劃至2017年12月31日為止。

HKUGA Primary School New Extension Building

Build bricks to extend our dream

HKUGA Primary School (“the School”) was set up in 2000 by HKUGA Education Foundation (“the Education Foundation”) as a co-educational school under the direct-subsidy scheme to provide quality education for our young generation. It forms a 12-year through-train school system with HKUGA College established in 2006 by the Education Foundation.

During its 15 years since opening, the School has become a learning community with joy and proves to be very popular among parents and is well-recognized within the education profession. Its teachers have received awards for teaching excellence in the two years from 2014 to 2016 and its students have been awarded numerous prizes and awards in academic, sport, art and other inter-school activities and competitions. In 2015, the two top ranking students of HKUGA College in the Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education examination came from the School. In 2017, 5,773 applications were received for admission to our 120 seats in P1.

New Learning Facilities, New Modes of Learning and Teaching

The School’s facilities are now insufficient to meet our future learning and teaching needs. An extension building of about 10,000 sq. ft. is under plan to provide additional space for whole-person and experiential learning. This includes:

- A bigger library – around 1,800 sq.ft., to encourage reading and independent learning;
- A multi-function hall – about 130 seats and a small stage, for whole-form experiential learning and integrated art activities, and also for parent and education community use;
- A STEM workshop – for science, technology, mathematics and engineering learning activities, and to facilitate our students to create, design and practice;
- A roof-top garden – for students to do hands-on agricultural gardening activities so as to nurture their concepts of sustainability.

The Stars Scheme - a fund raising scheme for the school new extension

In line with the schools’ vision and better engagement with the HKU alumni, parents and all stakeholders, the Education Fund has proposed the following “Stars Scheme” fundraising programme to support the school extension building project as follows:

- An individual donor (or a donor group) who donates HK\$15,000 or more will sponsor a “Star”.
- The Stars include Diamond Star Honour (HK\$1,000,000 or higher), Platinum Star Honour (HK\$500,000), Gold Star Honour (HK\$200,000), Premium Star Honour (HK\$100,000), Silver Star Honour (HK\$45,000) and Bronze Star Honour (HK\$15,000);
- The total number of stars sponsored by the donors (or donor groups) will be inscribed on a wall at the extension building to signify "Happy Learning" in the campus.
- The actual size, location and format of the Stars are subject to the final design of the architect, and also subject to the endorsement by the Incorporated Management Committee of the School. Details will be announced later;
- To recognize the support of the donors, the donor names will be listed on the wall erected at the extension building and next to the list is a landscape picture of their sponsored “Stars”.
- Closing date for the Stars Scheme donation is 31 December, 2017.

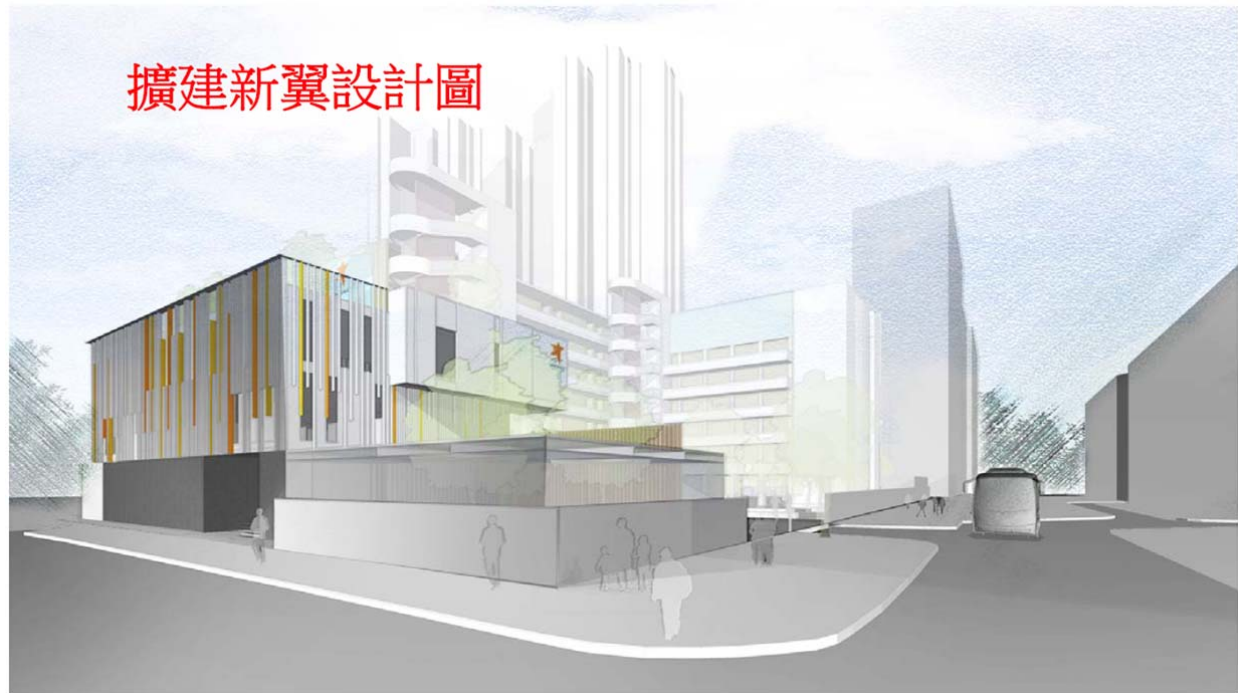

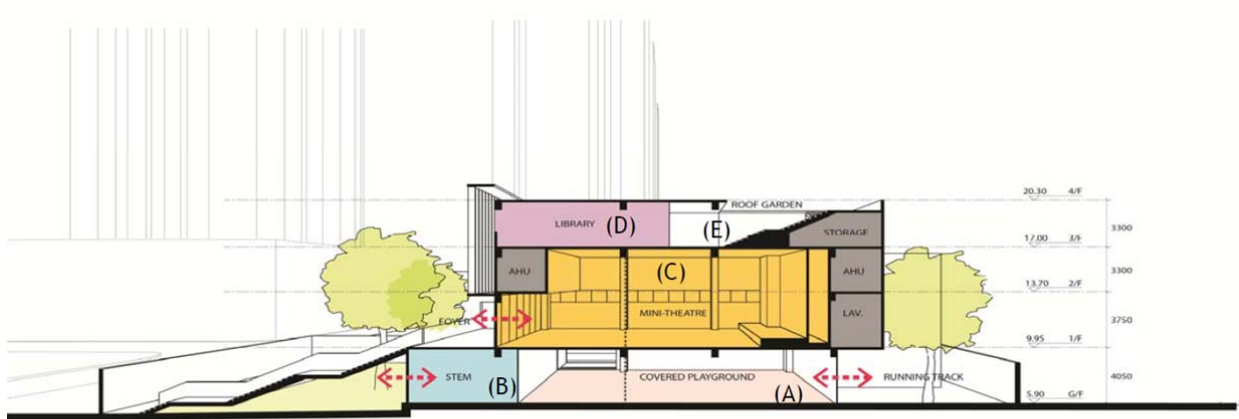


HKUGA Primary School New Extension Building
